Invitation for starting ASAP Trainings in Government & Aided Schools
& Colleges-reg

Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP) is a joint initiative of Department of Higher Education and General Education, Government of Kerala to impart employable skills to students studying in Higher Secondary Schools and Arts and Science Colleges.

This foundation module, common to all the students enrolled for ASAP training, consists of Communicative English Skills (100 hours) and IT Skills (80 hours) to be imparted through the affiliated training institutions. This will be followed by industry specific skill programmes in different sectors including Health care, Hospitality, Telecom, Finance, Printing, Rubber Technology, Retail etc to be imparted through identified Skill training centres with the student having the liberty to choose the Programme of their choice (subject to availability of the Programme at a centre). All the Classes will be handled by Skill Development executives from the industry or by those trained by the industry.

ASAP intends to partner with Government and Aided Schools and Colleges to start the skill programmes for First year Higher Secondary students/first year under graduate students. A maximum of two batches, each with a maximum of 30 students, would be sanctioned to an institution, subject to availability of Skill Development Executives and decisions of the Government.

ASAP invites applications from Government and Aided Higher Secondary schools and Colleges for affiliation as ASAP training Institutions.

Government/Aided Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges which are passionate to transform the skill landscape of the state can apply online by visiting <http://www.asapkerala.gov.in/affiliation> on or before 30th September, 2013 to be considered as ASAP Training Institution.

An undertaking in the prescribed format (Available in the website) on Stamp Paper worth Rs 100/ has to be given by the institution. The scanned copy of the duly signed undertaking has to be uploaded in the space provided for, in the online application form.
