Having realised that most of the college students in Kerala are ignorant of the immense scope and importance of the Civil Services Examination conducted by the UPSC for selecting meritorious candidates for the top civil service posts in our country, Kerala State Civil Service Academy, established by the State Government under Centre for Continuing Education Kerala, is organising an awareness programme on the Civil Service Examination in the first week of January 2012 with the Maharaja's College, Ernakulam; Government Victoria College, Palakkad; Government Arts and Science College, Meenchanta, Kozhikode and the Government Guesthouse, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram as venues.

- For the students of Ernakulam, Kottayam, and Idukki districts, the awareness programme is at Maharaja's College (January 4, 2012).
- For the students of Palakkad and Thrissur districts the awareness programme is at the Government Victoria College, Palakkad (January 5, 2012).
- The students of Malappuram, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Kannur and Kasargod districts to attend the programme at Government Arts and Science College, Kozhikode (January 6, 2012).
- Govt Guesthouse, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram (January 17, 2012) for the students of Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam and Alleppey districts.
