**ORDER**

The Government vide order read as first paper above have issued orders for implementing UGC pay revision to Teachers in Universities Affiliated Colleges, Teachers in Law Colleges and Engineering Colleges and Kerala Agricultural University, Kerala veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean studies and Teachers in Physical Education and qualified Librarians under University Grants Commission. Government vide order read as second paper above, UGC Regulations, on minimum qualification for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in universities and Colleges and for the measure standards in Higher Education 2018 was implemented in the State, subject to the condition that where there are any provisions in the Regulations inconsistent with the provisions in the Government Order read first paper above, those provisions in the Government Order would override the provisions in the regulations to the extent of such inconsistency.

As per the clause 6.3 of the above UGC regulations 2018, "The criteria for promotions under Career Advancement Scheme laid down under these Regulations shall be effective from the date of notification of these Regulations. However, to avoid hardship to those faculty members who have already qualified or are likely to qualify shortly under the existing regulations, a choice may be given to them, for being considered for promotions under the existing Regulations. This option can be exercised only within three years from the date of notification of these Regulations."

The Director of Collegiate Education, vide letter read as third paper above, has submitted a proposal before Government to modify the clause of the Government

order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, by inserting clause 6.3 of UGC regulations on Minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and for the measure of Standards in Higher Education 2018.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to insert the following additional clause as 5.2(A) in between clause 5.2 and 5.3 of the GO read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above. :-

“5.2(a) In accordance with clause 6.3 of UGC regulations on Minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and for the measure of Standards in Higher Education 2018, the option of Career Advancement Scheme under UGC regulations 2010 with relaxed API shall be given to the teachers up to 17/07/2021 (ie, within three years from the date of notification of UGC regulations 2018)”

The GO read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above will stand modified to the above extent.
